- \*A referral rebate of \$1000 will be awarded to any existing CCA family that:
  - \*Refers a new student to enroll and attend Calvary Christian Academy for the 2024-25 school year.
  - \*Former students and siblings of current students do not qualify as a new student referral.
  - \*Only full-time, full-day students qualify as a new student referral.
  - \*This New Student Referral Coupon must be presented to the office at the new student's initial interview. Verbal coupons will not be honored. Coupons presented after 07/31/2024 will not be honored.
- \*Rebates will be posted to the family's account on 11/01/24. Rebates are void if new student withdraws before 11/01/24.
- \*There is no limit to the number of referrals a family may claim. The amount of referral rebate cannot exceed the total annual tuition charge for a family. Any rebate amount over the total annual tuition charge for a family will be forfeited.

If the school needs to close or delay opening for inclement weather, families will be notified through the following means:

Any decisions will be made by 6:30 am; if there is no announcement by 6:30 am, school will be open in the morning as usual. While CCA generally follows Unit 5 regarding cancellations/delays, be aware that CCA does not always follow their decisions.

In case of severe weather during the school day, students will remain at school until they are dismissed. In the event of a tornado, it is safer for students to remain at school than to be picked up and transported.

Please do not call the school during severe weather, as it is critical to have the phone lines open in case of an emergency, and answering the phones takes personnel away from their primary job to supervise students and watch the weather situation. Should it be determined in the best interest of students and staff to dismiss students early, CCA will notify parents via email, website, and Facebook. A staff member will remain at school until all students have been picked up by a parent or legal guardian.
