# IOWA ACHIEVEMENT TESTS - NEXT WEEK

Next week, all students K-9th Grades will be taking the annual IOWA Achievement tests. Most test sections will be taken in the mornings--Monday-Thursday. #### **ECLIPSE**



Next Monday, Bloomington/Normal will witness between 90-96% (depending on which reports you read) of the solar eclipse. With that CCA will be doing the following:

- Normal recesses within 3 hours on either side of the totality (@2:04 locally) will be held indoors to protect all of our students eyes from any possible danger from the solar radiation.
- 2. During the totality, students in Grades 1–12 with completed permission slips will be going outside to view the eclipse. All students will be supervised and required to wear special glasses to shield their eyes from damaging radiation. CCA received a donation of glasses for the elementary students and purchased glasses for the JH and SH students.
