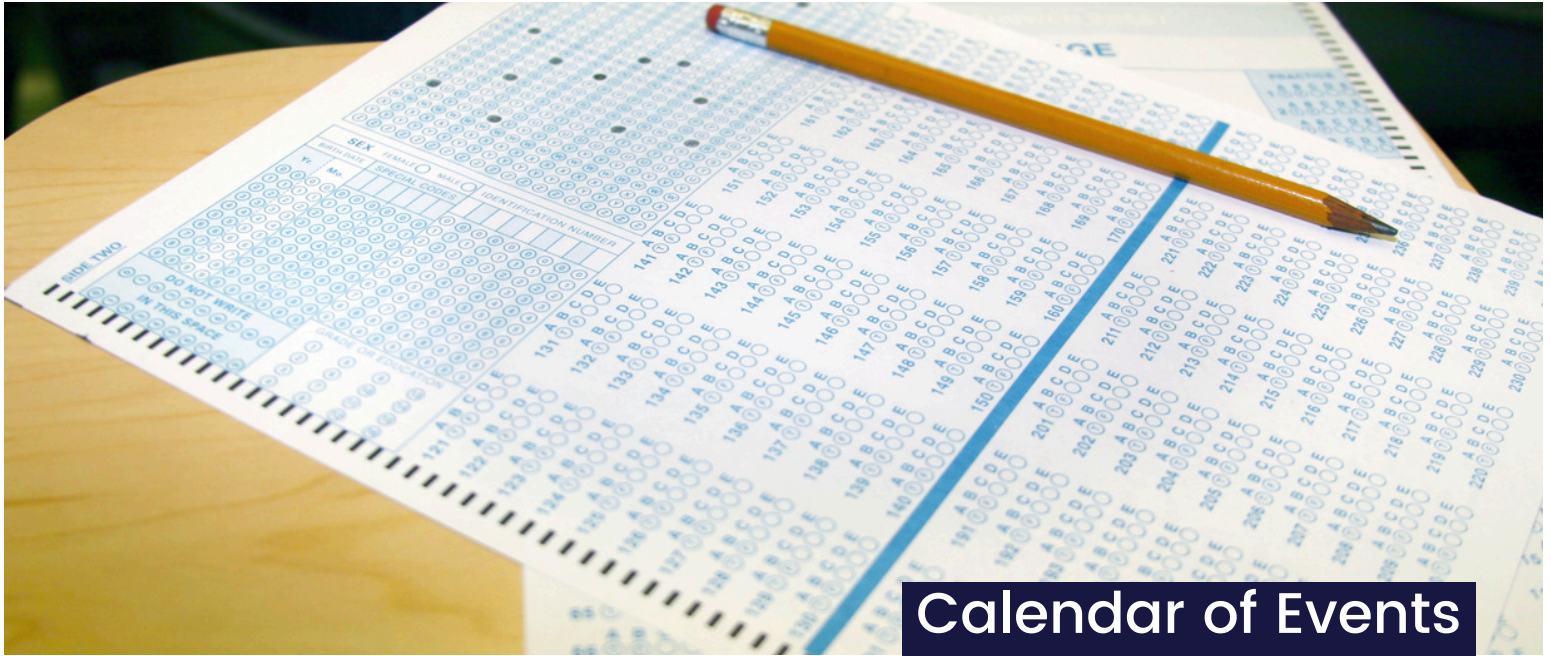

Achievement Testing

Beginning next Monday, the K5-9th Grades will be taking the annual achievement tests. Just as parents look at test scores to evaluate your child's progress, CCA utilizes test scores to evaluate curriculum, class progress, etc. Consider the following ideas to help make next week a little more stress-free and fun for the students:

- Make sure students get to bed on time
 - Proper rest helps students focus well during testing
- Have a healthy breakfast each morning
 - Some families make breakfast special this week by allowing kids to pick the meals each day or by serving breakfast in bed--make it fun!
- Be careful not to add pressure to score well
 - These tests are designed to show the yearly progress students make. They have no effect on report cards or college entrance. Keep a balanced perspective.

Re-enrollment for the 2025-26 academic year is now open. Mark the deadlines above to save up to \$300 off the Re-enrollment Fee (\$500 after April 4). *Only full-time, full-day students qualify as a new student referral.

*This New Student Referral Coupon must be presented to the office at the new student's initial interview. Verbal coupons will not be honored. Coupons presented after 07/31/2025 will not be honored.

*Rebates will be posted to the family's account on 11/01/25. Rebates are void if new student withdraws before 11/01/25.

*There is no limit to the number of referrals a family may claim. The amount of referral rebate cannot exceed the total annual tuition charge for a family. Any rebate amount over the total annual tuition charge for a family will be forfeited.
